MOST MEDICATIONS DO NOT INTERFERE WITH ALLERGY SKIN TESTING, AND CAN BE CONTINUED;

- Steroid nasal sprays (Aselin, Astepro, Flonase, Nasonex, Nasacort AQ, Patanase, Rhinocort, etc.)
- Asthma medications (Albuterol, Flovent, Singulair, Advair, etc.)
- Antibiotics
- Eye drops for allergy (Patanol, Zaditor, etc.)
- Decongestants (Sudafed, Prolex D, etc.)
- Medicines for other conditions such as diabetes, arthritis, reflux, most high blood pressure medications, birth control pills, etc.
